Project Seahunt encourages experts to fill in missing information about planned cruises by providing a public platform for ongoing conversations to take place.

## PROJECT SEAHUNT

New cruises are entered by users.

Entered cruises are searchable by multiple parameters.

Users suggest changes, post notes, and respond to others.

Suggestions are approved and the cruise metadata is updated.
